BOONE CO SO TF	<p>During this quarter the Task Force began seeing an increasing problem with electronic devices and juveniles. The trend among juveniles is in possession of smart phones, tablets and downloading applications. The smart phones are becoming more prevalent amongst children younger than 10 years old. The children are accessing applications where the child had to falsify their age to get on the account. Among the problems with juveniles; we are seeing young juveniles soliciting juveniles to take nude images of themselves and then the images are shared on trending applications such as Kik, Snapchat or Instagram. In November 2014, the Task Force investigated a case that had been referred to us by NCIS, the Navel Criminal Investigative Service. Information given to us by NCIS indicated a person from the South Carolina area wanted to have sex with a two young females from the Mexico, Missouri area. The Task Force learned the suspect wanted to pay the girls a large amount of money to have sex with him. The girls eventually created a sex video for the suspect and sent the video through a electronic device. The Task Force continues to educate children about the dangers and how to prevent from becoming a victim to online predators. The Task Force continues to get request for presentations from schools in the mid-Missouri area.</p>

During this time frame the KRCCU utilized an undercover profile of a 13 year old female who was contacted by a subject who identified themselves as an over the road truck driver. The trucker allegedly sent the undercover KRCCU detective numerous messages of a graphic sexual nature and made arrangements to meet what he thought was a 13 year old female in Kirksville for sex. The trucker arrived in town and parked his semi-truck at a local business before leaving it to meet the 13 year old girl. It is alleged the trucker traveled from Illinois to Kirksville en route to make his delivery in Kansas. Officers and Detectives with the Kirksville Police Department made contact with the subject (identified as Jason Dodge; age: 40 of Eureka, Kansas) and he was subsequently placed under arrest for attempted enticement of a child.</p> <p>Jeremy Brady - The Kirksville Regional Computer Crimes Unit (KRCCU) began an investigation into the area Registered Sex Offenders who had online social media profiles. By law Sex Offenders have to register all of their online social media websites/profiles with their local law enforcement. During this time frame the KRCCU identified Jeremy "Brett" Brady (32 of Newark, Mo) as having an online profile which was not registered. The KRCCU was able to establish contact with Brady using an undercover persona of a 13 year old female. A conversation/chat ensued between Brady and the undercover detective. Allegedly Brady sent messages about wanting to engage in a sexual relationship with the 13 year old female. Brady is suspected of sending nude images of himself to the female he believed to be 13 along with requesting nude images of the girl in return. Brady</p>

MO DEPT SOCIAL SERVICES - STAT	In this quarter STAT continued to assist the St. Louis County Special Investigations Unit by conducting forensic computer examinations in support of their ongoing Peer to Peer undercover child pornography investigations. Also STAT had a series of cases where the High Tech unit supported and assisted several child molestation/sexual abuse of children cases. Five of the seven arrests this quarter were related to those cases.
MO STATE HIGHWAY PATROL - DIGITAL UN!	In addition to working our own investigations into the exploitation of children, we all run a full service computer forensic laboratory. The vast majority of the 'others' listed on this report are from cases brought to us by local law enforcement that need technical assistance with criminal investigations. Departments assisted include: Morgan County Sheriff, Maries Co Sheriff, Rolla Police Department, East Central Drug Task Force, Caruthersville Police, Moberly Police, Fulton Police, Jefferson City Police, Laclede County Sheriff, Missouri Attorney General, and Missouri Department of Conservation
NE JACKSON CO GRP	Detective Garner continues to work as part of the FBI Child Exploitation Task Force and works on both assigned and self-initiated child pornography and child exploitation related cases. Detective Garner participated in three additional task force search warrant executions Detective Garner participated in two additional task force search warrant executions. Detective Garner conducted four subject interviews and two victim interviews regarding child exploitation and child pornography possession. Det. Garner attended the Plea hearing in federal court involving the following subject regarding a child pornography possession and distribution investigation Tracy J. Yost, w/m, 01/28/1971, 491-88-2572. Yost plead guilty to the three count Indictment and was taken into custody by Deputy; U.S. Marshal Michael Valentine Detective Garner attended two FBI sponsored training session: Digital Recording of Subjects. Law Enforcement Emotional Survival Training. Detective Nunez completed (4) peer reviews of coworkers forensic examinations during this reporting period. She also examined approximately 1890GB of data extracted from items recovered by L/E agencies whose cases were subsequently assigned to her by the HARCFL. In addition, early in November, the Task Force was requested to assist the Kansas City MetroSquad with a homicide investigation, which pulled four (4) TFO's from their regular responsibilities.

POPLAR BLUFF - SEMO TF

During this reporting period we conducted compliance checks on seventy five registered sex offenders living in our task force area. This resulted in the referral of felony charges (failure to register as a sex offender) on four suspects.

ST. CHARLES CO CYBER UNIT

In October 2014, a suspect was arrested on grand jury indictment for child pornography found during a search executed the prior year by the St. Charles County Cyber Crime Task Force. In October 2014, the St. Charles County Cyber Crime Task Force assisted the FBI with a CP Production case. The St. Charles County Cyber Crime Task Force assisted Troy PD in an Enticement case that will be taken federal. In November 2014, the St. Charles County Cyber Crime Task Force assisted the Osage Beach Police Department execute a local search warrant and also identify live victims from the suspects phone.
