The Buchanan County Drug Strike Force has made a strong effort to focus manpower to illegal prescription drug use/sales. We have a huge problem with illegal prescription drug usage in our Task Force Area. We have three investigators assigned to the local Drug Court sessions. One investigator focuses the majority of his time on only illegal prescription drug enforcement. We have made some very strong cases against some of our top targets, in our illegal prescription drug trade. We foresee adding additional resources to the illegal prescription drug trade, for our Task Force area. The reason for the additional resources is need. Illegal prescription pills have become a common trade in our area.

CLAY CO DTF

In our shift to adding more interdiction activities to our task force, during this reporting period one of our detectives was transferred to the DEA Group 44 Interdiction Squad. He works there full time and is 100% dedicated to interdiction activities. Their group concentrates on the bus station, train station, KCI airport and hotel/motels located in our metro area. Our ongoing DEA conspiracy case is growing. After our first round on indictments and initial interviews, the DTF is working with DEA on a second round of indictments. We are hoping to have approximately 10 suspects included in the next round of indictments.

CNET

CNET is in desperate need of more funding.

COMET

COMET recently gained 2 more counties in their service area. With only 8 investigators serving 9 counties, we hope to become fully staffed next grant year and possibly add a new position in order to effectively combat illegal narcotics.

EAST CENTRAL DTF

Our Task Force doubled in size in April, due to the great work by our Task Force Officers, their arrests, their community involvement and positive coverage of the Task Force in the media. Our task force has doubled in size, from 3 to 6 counties. The 3 new counties were Cooper, Howard, and Pike. For the past few years, Pike County has not been served by a task force and Cooper and Howard Counties who have been served by a task force in recent years were leaving their task force at the end of the current grant period, and would be turning white in color along with Pike, on the map. Along with the 3 new counties/sheriff's offices who were accepted by our Executive Board of Directors, our board also accepted 3 new police departments to our Task Force. In total (in April) we added 6 new signing members of our memorandum of understanding, to our Task Force bringing our total of signing members to 15; with at least one other municipality inquiring about membership. We have added immensely to our service/coverage area by accepting these areas and removed three `white counties` from the State Map. By the close of year one, we believe that our Task Force will has met the objectives of the state's three-year plan. Our undercover officer continues to conduct covert investigations (drug buys and free samples listed on Page 3) including a lengthy cold investigation (without an informant). Cold Investigations are usually very time consuming and tiresome but can eventually turn into an enormous

success including evidence purchasing and intelligence gathering. Our officers' current investigation is not only bearing fruit but has been able to assist by gathering intelligence in regard to other ongoing investigations. All undercover investigations require more man-power than realized. Due to the requirement (policy of Missouri State Highway Patrol) regarding surveillance of officers for the undercover officer, each time an undercover officer is working. During an undercover operation, the need for surveillance (primarily for the safety of our officer) can at times leave one officer to cover the remaining 5 counties of our Task Force service/coverage area. Our task force continues to work a Federal wiretap investigation, with the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), with primary targets of the investigation residing within our Task Force coverage area. These type of investigations are typically very successful and have a large impact on the Drug Trafficking Organizations which victimize our citizens. The East Central Drug Task Force had two (2) officers attend the Patrol's Basic and Advanced Narcotics Trainings at the Missouri State Highway Patrol's Law Enforcement Academy. Three (3) officers were also instructors at the training. This quarter our Task Force also seized eighty five (85) firearms and recovered approximately fifty thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars in stolen property.

FRANKLIN CO NARC

During this quarter we were involved in 3 major federal Title III wire intercept cases with the DEA, DHS, and FBI. We also worked with the DEA on a major Mexican methamphetamine case and purchased 4 kilograms of methamphetamine undercover.

JACKSON CO MJDTF

Jackson County Drug Task Force, Drug Enforcement Administration, Kansas City, Kansas Police Department and the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department executed two search warrants in reference to an on-going Task Force investigation. The Hispanic male suspects were determined to be brothers, connected to the Sinaloa Cartel in Mexico. The brothers were supplying large amounts of methamphetamine and cocaine to be distributed in Independence and other areas in eastern Jackson County, Missouri. Recovered during subsequent searches: 39 ounces of methamphetamine 2 ounces of cocaine Small amount of marijuana Prescription pills One stolen handgun The investigation continues.

JASPER CO DTF

In July Task Force Officers arrested Eric Meyer during a Search Warrant at 723 Jackson in Joplin. Meyer was in possession of two guns and 32 grams of meth. Meyer is a convicted felon and charges were filed on the Federal side. Task Force Officers also arrested Merriam Deleon and Israel Delmonte for possession of over a pound and a half of meth. Detectives also arrested Brian Ashton for possession with intent and weapons charges. Ashton was in possession of 3 ounces of Ice and two stolen guns. In August the Task Force initiated 24 investigations seizing a total of 77.4 grams of meth and 610 grams of high grade marijuana. Task Officers also located and arrested Bobby Cope who was wanted on a warrant for Manslaughter. Most of September was spent preparing for a roundup on a federal investigation where 11

JASPER CO DTF	suspects were indicted on conspiracy to distribute meth and weapons charges. On October 75 suspects were located and arrested in the federal case Operation Lion King 6 other suspects were already in custody on other charges.
KANSAS CITY MJDTF	The task force is still working on establishing positive contacts with the public. No obstacles have been encountered.
LAFAYETTE CO NARC	The Lafayette County Drug Task Force stats for the first quarter are slightly down from last year first quarter. The Lafayette County Drug Task Force received a large amount of intelligence, which cultivated several confidential informants in reference to narcotics sales and use. Several of these new informants were farmed out to other agencies, the Jackson County DTF, the Missouri State Highway Patrol DDCC and the Warrensburg Missouri Police Dept, which is in Johnson County and who is not attached to a Drug Task Force with a MOU. The Lafayette County Drug Task Force believes with the numerous new drug intelligence and informants, the next grant quarter should reflect better stats.
LANEG	LANEG continues to focus its major efforts on combating the illegal drug trade in the six (6) county task force area. Marijuana, illegal sale of prescription medication and heroin sales remain present in certain areas of the task force, but have not appeared to increase. The task force continues to see a large number of abandoned and active methamphetamine laboratories. The processing and disposal of these labs continue to be a strain on available man hours. Hydroponic marijuana and methamphetamine `ice` sales and availability have appeared to increase in the task force area. LANEG officers continue to see a decrease in the sale of synthetic marijuana and bath salts by local distributors. This decrease may be a direct result from aggressive investigations and local distributors being informed of the illegal nature and laws concerning the sales of synthetic drugs. LANEG is currently participating in several federal investigations involving the distribution of crystal methamphetamine and synthetic drugs. LANEG officers have initiated and are currently involved in undercover investigations focusing on known drug distributors in the task force area. LANEG is currently working with and de-conflicting drug investigations with other task forces in Troop D, Troop F and Troop G. During this reporting period LANEG gave four separate presentations on the current activities and trends of the Sovereign Citizen movement and its impact on the state and local communities. LANEG attended a Laclede County Drug awareness meeting with local political representatives, city and county public officials, business leaders and civic organizations reference the current drug problem in Laclede County. The participants discussed ways to decrease the drug problem facing the county by developing courses of action in addition to law enforcement, to include drug courts, rehabilitation services and public awareness.

MID-MO MJDTF MINERAL AREA DTF	Members of the Task Force seized 8 and a half pounds Meth during a traffic stop and search warrant. During the reporting period the Mineral Area Drug Task Force was able to assist the St. Francois County Sheriff's Office and DEA with a joint ICE Investigation, where officers from the Mineral Area Drug Task Force acting in an undercover capacity, purchased trafficking amounts of ICE form a suspect, who was then turned witness by the DEA to deal with a large ICE distribution network from Mexico. This investigation, once concluded, will net a major drug trafficking network in Missouri, Kansas, Texas
MUSTANG	The MUSTANG Drug Task Force applied 12 search warrants and executed 10 of them in Cole and Callaway Counties. They resulted in the seizure of \$8,569 in US currency and 4 firearms. *MUSTANG did not have an active grant during this reporting period.
NEMO TF	Agents are currently working on federal cases. These cases require many Task Force man hours. We also received resignation of 2 officers during this reporting period.
NITRO	NITRO was involved in 2 different title III investigations during the reporting period. The first one was during the month of July and during the first week in August 6 search warrants were applied for (not by NITRO) but NITRO did serve two of the search warrants in Boone County. During the execution of the warrants drugs and 3 firearms were seized. The second title III was in the Kansas City area and ran during the month of September. The wire just ended and indictments are being prepared. NITRO officers worked in the wire room and on surveillance during both wires. 4 search warrants were served in Ray County after a subject shot at two ATF agents. NITRO officers assisted in the execution of the warrants. The search warrants were for vehicles as well as the residence. 18 firearms were seized along with a small amount of methamphetamine. The last search warrant was applied for (by Daviess County) and served in Daviess County and 3 firearms were seized. During one of the arrests 372 grams of methamphetamine was seized. During July NITRO officers were required to attend two different trainings one a three day training and the other a two day training. The training involved ATF policy. During September a 4 hour post approved training session conducted at the Grundy County Law Enforcement Center. The training was about working drug cases, dealing with informants, making buys and applying for and executing search warrants.
NOMO DTF	NOMO DTF officers completed a (2) yearlong investigation in Macon County. As a result (23) individuals were arrested on a total of (55) charges. Of those (23) individuals, (9) were known felons and (16) of those individuals were charged with drug charges that occurred within 2000 feet of schools. These investigations have led to ongoing investigations in (2) connecting counties. Note that a roundup of this size in a county the size of Macon (15,500) has a significant impact on the community. NOMO assisted one of our agencies (Knox Co.) by setting and monitoring cameras on a marijuana patch in a rural area and eventually the cutting and disposing of approximately 4500 plants. Knox Co. Sheriff also

NOMO DTF	requested our assistance in an investigation of a known violent offender that while out on bond was intimidating witnesses. NOMO was able to obtain the intell necessary to apply for and receive a Search Warrant which resulted in the arrest of this individual. One of the NOMO officers worked as the undercover agent in a drug investigation that began in Milan, MO. NITRO was contacted when the opportunity presented to our officer to make a drug purchase in Cameron, MO and Kansas City, MO. Working with NITRO our officer made drug purchases in those locations and as a result the individual was arrested federally and is awaiting disposition.
PLATTE CO MEG	Major case work and training were focused on during this reporting quarter. SWAT, Reid Interview & Interrogation, Defensive Tactics and Basic Criminal Investigations are a sample of the training PCMEG detectives hosted/attended. A significant cache of THC wax in various forms was discovered in a rural trailer park area as the result of a disturbance call. PCMEG was called in by responding officers and a sizable amount of illegal narcotics packaged for distribution was discovered along with \$40,000+ in cash and weapons. Both suspects were identified and charged accordingly. PCMEG additionally continued to focus any free investigative-time on working with local jurisdictions in the eradication of drug nuisance home(s); heroin & meth traffic apparently resulting in the degradation of these local neighborhoods.
SEMO DTF	Officers continued a yearlong undercover investigation in Dunklin County which culminated in grand jury indictments on 36 individuals for distribution of controlled substances which included marijuana, methamphetamine and a variety of prescription drugs. Approximately 26 arrests have been made so far in the investigation. In September, officers executed a search warrant which resulted in the seizure of approximately 1.4 pounds of `ice` methamphetamine and over \$23,000 in currency.
SOUTHWEST MO DTF	We have completed the move into the Barry County Sheriff's Office and constructed a secure evidence room in the garage of the building. All new evidence will be placed into the sheriff's evidence in the county of seizure. We have spent considerable time and effort on an informant claiming to have ties with the Mexican mafia in Arkansas. Agent Luckey has coordinated this information with DEA, FBI, and Arkansas State Police. To date the CI's performance has been disappointing. His claims has not matched his performance. Agent Luckey is attempting to get a meth buy through him in Missouri, then turn him over to Arkansas authorities. We have also been working a 2nd CI that has been productive in making buys in Missouri and Stone County, Missouri working with a COMET task force agent. We are withholding pending arrests to protect his identity as he is still productive in both counties. We attempted a pseudo pill sting at the Cassville MO Walmart store. This store has had heavy pseudo sales to residents of Missouri and Arkansas. On the day we were there only 2 boxes were sold. We will attempt additional operations there. We conducted one marijuana eradication flight in Barry County and seized 200 mature plants from

SOUTHWEST MO DTF	3 patches. Additional patches have been located by ground efforts. We are also updating our computer equipment and have started using the HTS cloud drive for secure data storage. Currently, we are in a struggle to set up in our new working environment and keep up with the large amount of field intelligence that is coming in daily. This coming quarter we are also going to concentrate on meeting our objective of providing drug awareness and safety training to local law enforcement and fire fighters.
ST CHARLES CO DTF	In addition to the above information, our task force completed 70 undercover narcotics purchases during the quarter. In the month of September, we began our Heroin Initiative in cooperation with the DEA. As a result of the initiative, the DEA has assigned one agent and one TFO to our unit fulltime. More on the initiative will be available in the coming months.
ST LOUIS CO MJDTF	From August 9, 2014 thru October 31, 2014, all task force officers were involved in the Ferguson Protests/riots and meetings/training for the upcoming decision from the Grand Jury. Therefore, our numbers are low during this quarter and will most likely be low part of the next quarter.
