What is MOVANS?

The Missouri Victim Automated Notification System (MOVANS) is a free service of the Missouri Department of Public Safety to provide victims of crime with automated updates on their offender's current custody status, upcoming court events, and ex-parte or full orders of protection. MOVANS is a great tool for victims—but only if they know about it! Local agencies are crucial in letting victims know about MOVANS and helping them get registered.

How can I learn more?

MOVANS training is always free, and offered to professionals of all backgrounds who come in contact with crime victims in their line of work.

The hour-long training will provide an overview of a victim's right to notification as outlined in RSMO 595.209, how MOVANS works, how victims can sign up, and what users can expect once they are registered. MOVANS is available 24/7, anonymous, and easy to use.
