*What is VINEWatch?*

VINEWatch is a free service of the Missouri Department of Public Safety that provides law enforcement, advocates, etc. the capability to determine the custody status of an offender, register to be notified of court events for themselves or a victim, and run numerous other helpful reports. VINEWatch is a great tool for law enforcement and advocates—but only if you know about it!

VINEWatch training is always free, and offered to professionals of all backgrounds who come in contact with crime victims in their line of work.
