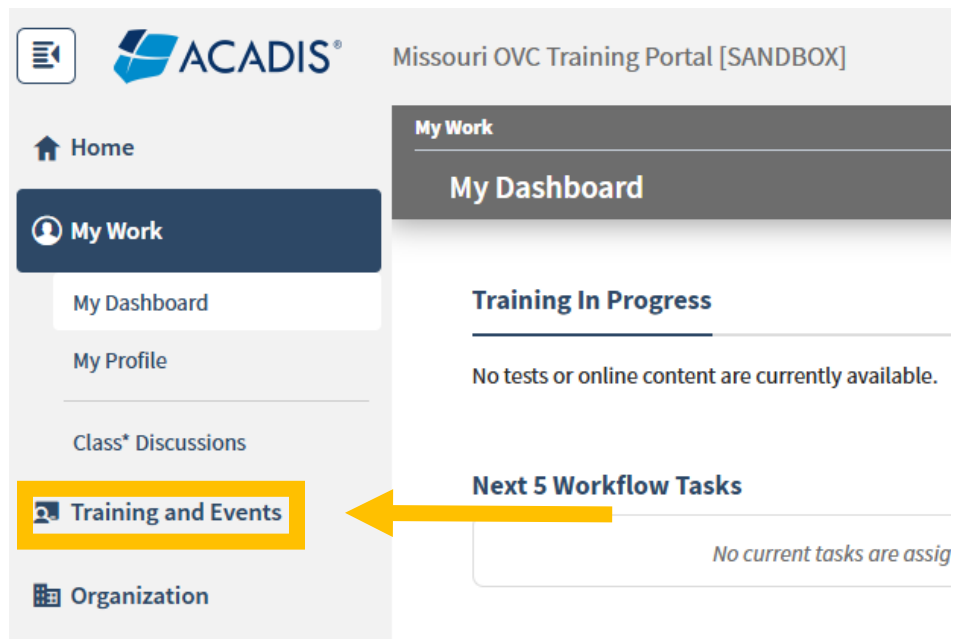

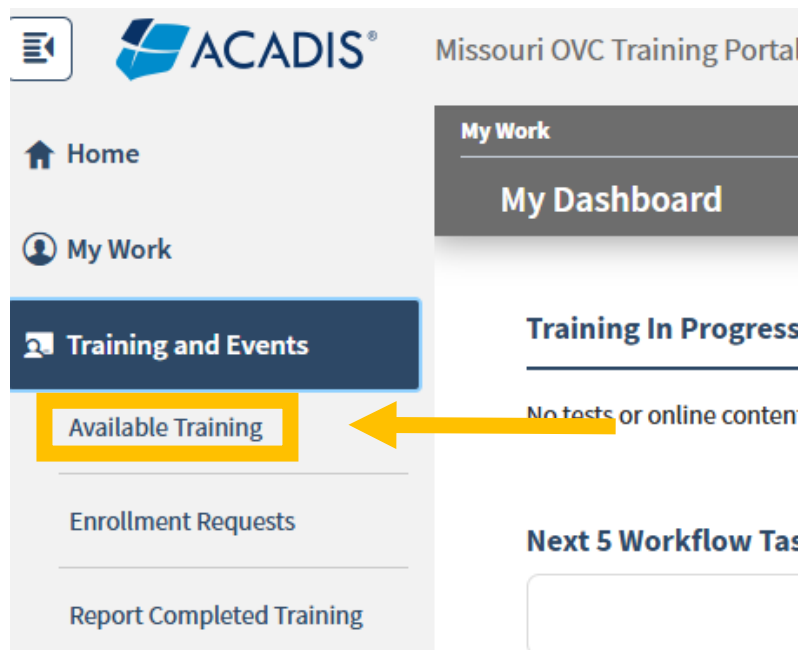


Registering for MVSA
