The Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) grant is being transitioned to the Department of Social Services (DSS), Division of Finance and Administrative Services (DFAS) and will be administered by our agency beginning July 1, 2017. The Department of Public Safety (DPS) and DSS have been working diligently to ensure a smooth transition.

Current subrecipients may continue to submit monthly invoices at a time of their choosing for costs incurred through September 30, 2017 utilizing WebGrants. Final invoices for this grant period should be submitted on or before December 15, 2017. DSS will process all invoices received via WebGrants upon receipt.

DSS has received all applications for the Fiscal Year 2018 contract period. Updated invoicing procedures will be communicated with the contract award.
