Policy Title: Member Agency Fleet Mapping

Purpose and Scope:

To establish policy for the Missouri Statewide Interoperability Network (MOSWIN) Fleet Mapping.

Fleetmapping- Is the process of developing talkgroups for specific use within a wide area trunked radio system. MOSWIN is a wide area trunked radio system.

In these systems "talkgroups" replace the term "channels" as voice paths for use by public safety personnel. Talkgroups are defined by the agency at the system level and can be for agency specific operations or for inter-agency communications.

Policy:

- 1. All radios utilized on the MOSWIN network must have the designated regional and statewide interoperability and event talkgroups for their respective region programmed for multi-discipline use as provided by MOSWIN System Administration. No member agency will be permitted to alter the MOSWIN Regional and/or Statewide baseline talkgroups as the use of common talkgroups in each radio promotes statewide interoperability.
- 2. In addition to the baseline talkgroups identified above for all radios, member agencies will be allowed to add agency specific talkgroups to their radios by requesting talkgroups from MOSWIN System Administration. Costs associated with adding agency specific talkgroups will be the responsibility of the agency or entity.
- The addition or deletion of talkgroups and/or zones must be compatible with
 MOSWIN system operation and will be coordinated with the MOSWIN System Administration.
- 4. No radio can be programmed on the MOSWIN network without a signed MOSWIN Programming Security Agreement.
