The Homeland Security Information Network (HSIN) is a user-driven, web-based, unclassified information sharing platform that connects all homeland security mission partners. HSIN is available to federal, state, local, tribal, territorial and private sector homeland security partners free of charge, and is accessible from most locations with adequate internet service.

Missouri's HSIN communities offer a secure collaboration platform to our homeland security mission partners. To obtain access to Missouri's communities on HSIN, a request for access must be submitted to initiate the nomination process, and users must be vetted for appropriate access after completing the online registration and identity proofing steps.
