The City of Breckenridge Hills is currently accepting applications for the position of Police Officer. This is a full time position that requires the ability to work flexible hours.

A High School Diploma or GED is required. You must be at least 21 years of age and have the ability to practice law enforcement duties in a first class county as prescribed by the Missouri Department of Public Safety (POST.) Felony convictions and disqualifying criminal histories are not permitted. US citizenship as required by section 590.030 RSMO. You must have or be able to obtain a valid drivers' license without record of suspension or revocation in any state. A written test, oral interviews, a physical fitness assessment and a psychological evaluation are required prior to the actual hiring.

Starting salary is \$20.10 per hour. After a one year probationary period, salary increases to \$22.10 per hour. We offer health and dental benefits which include family coverage, life insurance, paid vacation, sick leave and a pension plan.
