Now Hiring One Full Time

The Greenfield Police Department has an immediate opening for One Full-time Police Officers. Greenfield is a small, rural town that is the County seat of Dade County. We have a population of approximately 1400 people. We are only a few miles from Stockton Lake and have an increase in traffic and calls during the summer months. Officers are responsible for law enforcement work involving the prevention, detection, and investigation of criminal acts, the apprehension, and arrest of law violators, and the safeguarding of lives and property. The Greenfield Police Department provides uniform (Shirt and Pants), Police radio, vehicle, and training. Applicant must have POST certificate (Class A or B), their own firearm, duty belt, handcuffs, and flash light.

Starting annual salary will be around \$31,000 with a raise after 6 month probation. The department also provides all full-time employees with fully paid health, dental, vision, and life insurance, along with vacation and sick leave.
