

The Parkville, Missouri Police Department is accepting applications for a Police Officer.

Parkville is a suburb of Kansas City, Missouri, is just over 15 square miles with a residential population of over 6,500. Parkville is connected by five state highways, one interstate, is the home of Park University and the National Golf Club, which has two golf courses.

Minimum requirement: Must be a certified Police Officer or currently attending a certified Police Academy and able to obtain at least a Missouri class B POST license at time of hire if out of State. No visible tattoos while wearing a short sleeve shirt.

Lateral Officers are encouraged to apply.

Uniforms and Equipment: The Parkville Police Department provides all starting, replacement equipment, and uniform items.

Vacation/Holiday Time: Every sworn member of the department receives 80 hours of vacation time per year for the first 5 years of employment (increasing thereafter). Officers also receive 11 paid holiday days a year.

Sick leave: Members accumulate 8 hours of sick leave per month which can be accumulated up to 960 hours. There is also paid time off for bereavement.

Tuition Reimbursement: There is a program in place for tuition reimbursement. A portion of a member's continuing education may be reimbursed by the city.
