PROPOSED RESCISSION

11 CSR 30-1.050. Approval of Motor Vehicle Safety Standard for Child Restraint System.
This established a rule relating to approval of child restraint systems for use in Missouri.

PURPOSE: This rule is being rescinded because it is no longer needed. The Missouri State Highway Patrol concurs that rescinding the rule will not affect their enforcement of the child restraint law.

AUTHORITY: sections 210.104 – 210.107, RSMo Supp. 1993. Original rule filed June 10, 1985, effective Aug. 26, 1985.*

PUBLIC COST: This proposed rescission will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.

PRIVATE COST: This proposed rescission will not cost private entities more than five hundred dollars (\$500) in the aggregate.
