PROPOSED RESCISSION

11 CSR 70-3.020 Guidelines for Sting Operations. The division is rescinding this regulation.

PURPOSE: This rule establishes guidelines for the use of minors in tobacco investigations by a state, county, municipal or other local law enforcement authority. It is duplicative of 407.934.5, and therefore should be rescinded.

AUTHORITY: section 407.934.5, RSMo Supp. [2001] 2018. Original rule filed Sept. 27, 2001, effective March 30, 2002. Rescinded: July 9, 2018.*

PUBLIC COST: This proposed amendment will not cost state agencies or political subdivisions.
