**PROPOSED RESCISSION**

**11 CSR 30-9.050 Organization Disqualification (Operation Payback).** This rule established the criteria for which a crime tip organization may be removed from, or denied entry into, the Operation Payback program.

*PURPOSE: The rule is being rescinded because the state legislature has not appropriated funds for this program since 2002.*
